A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

In daily discussion with some of the faithful of Our Lady of Hope Parish, there are people who are very nervous about the times which we find ourselves. Perhaps it is the leadership in the Church or the coming elections. People are seeing food prices on the rise and are very concerned about what we are to eat and how are we to pay for it. Wars between Russia and Ukraine, between Israel and Muslim countries, concern about China and Taiwan, climate worry...the list is so extensive. Are our times unique? Perhaps. I believe that the internet with its quick dissemination of information and even the distribution of false information has information both good and bad spreading like wildfire. We must remind ourselves that God is immovable and is all great; thus, He is our rock. Ultimately, we know where we want to go and therefore, our biggest concern should be our spiritual life. My concerns are whether I love God properly; do I serve Him well? Am I building up His Church or harming it; I am concerned as to whether I am a good pastor or not. I will vote, but the election does not depend on me. I will try to respect nature, but the climate concern is not on my back alone. We need to trust the Lord without reserve and know that in the end, this world is passing and heaven is our goal. Saint Patrick said in his *Confessions*, "For daily, I expect to be murdered or betrayed or reduced to slavery if the occasion arises. But I fear nothing, because of the promises of Heaven; for I have cast myself into the hands of Almighty God, who reigns everywhere. As the prophet says: 'Cast your burden on the Lord and He will sustain you.'" We need not live in paralyzing fear of this world for this world has no power over us if we are in Christ Jesus. We must pray and confidently be in His presence. We are greatly loved, and our Heavenly Father will sustain us no matter the attacks sprung upon us. Scripture says, "So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?'" (Hebrews 13:6). People are nervous, but the closer we are to Jesus and Our Lady, we will grow stronger, and nothing will rob us of our peace.




