### Saint Luke:

Saint Luke was born in Antioch, Syria. He was a Gentile by birth as well as a physician. It was later discovered he was also a painter. He was an early convert to the Faith and became a missionary companion for St. Paul, whom he accompanied on part of his second and third missionary journeys and attended in his Caesarean and Roman captivities. The unanimous tradition of the Church ascribes the third Gospel to Saint Luke. Allusions and citations from the Gospel are most frequent in early Christian writings, and even heretics made diligent use of this inspired book. As a historian, he is comparable with great Greek and Latin writers. In his Gospel, there is a steady movement of events from Nazareth to Jerusalem. Saint Luke is associated with "Good News". His feast day is October 18.
