A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

On October 12th, our Coadjutor Bishop, Joseph Williams, visited our campus to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our young people. It was a beautiful day in the spiritual life of our parish. Bishop Williams will become the Ordinary Bishop of Camden on March 17, 2025. His warmth and energy were felt by so many and there was an air of excitement as we welcomed Bishop Williams. The Bishop challenged our young people to not delay their response to the Holy Spirit to a more convenient time, but rather, he reminded us that the time is now! I was a bit sad that the huge majority of our newly confirmed did not attend Mass the day after their Confirmation and regretfully, fell into mortal sin since the Church teaches, as always, that to miss Sunday Mass without a serious reason, such as illness or for an emergency causes one to commit mortal sin. One of the things that Bishop Williams also said was that as a family his siblings and parents never missed Sunday Mass, even when on vacation. His very devout parents were Catholic to the core, and this inspired his family so much, that everyone, including young nieces and nephews, attend Mass every Sunday. Now that is inspiring! After the Confirmation, Fathers Polansky and Antony, along with Deacon Toby and I, enjoyed lunch with the Bishop. We truly enjoyed our time with our Bishop, and it is always a joy for clergy to be together. Speaking of clergy, in your charity, I ask you to continue to pray for Deacon Jack Werner. Deacon has been in the hospital, and we beg the Lord to heal him and to bring him back to us. I have known Deacon Jack for a long time, even before being made pastor of Our Lady of Hope, and I have always enjoyed my time with he who is not only a great deacon, but a true Catholic gentleman. Deacon Jack continues to work harder as a retired deacon than many active deacons. I miss his calm and pleasant presence. Lord grant Deacon Jack healing and good health; may Our Lady of Hope ask her Son for blessings for His good servant.

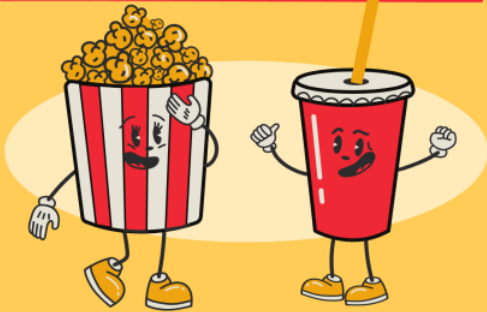

Saint John of Capistrano:

Saint John of Capistrano's one goal was to serve Jesus. As a young man, John was well educated, a successful lawyer, and a governor in the fourteenth-century Italy. He rid the region of political corruption. When he was sent to another province at the age of 26, he was captured and imprisoned. He soon realized he could serve God directly. When he was released from prison, he entered the Franciscan order. He soon joined Bernadine of Siena. While Bernadine preached, John heard Confessions. Pope Pius II recognized John for his strength and faith and asked him to help with the Turkish invasion in Hungary. John and his preaching skills along with the Hungarian army stopped the invasion. At age seventy, John was nothing but skin and bones but still had a strong spirit. He died of a disease he caught in battle. There is a mission in California named after John of Capistrano. He is the patron saint of jurists and military chaplains.
