A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

We rejoice in the recent installation as Acolyte of Paschal Nwako, who worships at Saint Agnes Church and Jose Garcia, who serves primarily at Saint Jude Church. Pascal hails from Nigeria and Jose from Mexico. They are both studying to be Permanent Deacons and have been formed over several years. Acolyte is a step towards ordination, a step that priests and deacons must take in order to prepare for ordination. The word Acolyte means a disciple or follower and these two men will serve at the altar in a special way, not yet as ordained men, but who now have a role at the altar in setting up, serving and distributing Holy Communion. You will see these new Acolytes don albs, but not yet a stole. I am proud of Paschal and Jose in their commitment to serving the Lord. Paschal serves as a sacristan at Saint Agnes Church, so he is very familiar with all that goes on at the altar. Continue to pray for perseverance for these men as they now are very close to possible ordination to the Permanent Diaconate. Both future deacons, who will be permanent, meaning they will always be deacons and not move on to the Holy Priesthood, are married and have children. They have a foot in two worlds, but I am confident that God will give them the grace to carry out their double vocations. As we speak of deacons, please continue to pray for Deacon Jack Werner that he will be strengthened and come home serving again at the altar. I also want to note that we had our first meeting of Living Christ. Once again, God has blessed our parish family as members are forming small groups to grow in faith, hope and love. The Holy Spirit is constantly building up the family of Our Lady of Hope. We are off to a great start, and I believe that the Lord is going to continue to give our family ways to make Jesus known and loved. We need to grow stronger as a parish family as I believe that times are coming that we will long to be in church, we will hunger for Holy Communion, we will want to be with other believers in Jesus Christ as evil is about to be unleashed. We must pray so much and especially for the world, that everyone will convert to Jesus Christ, Who told us, "No one comes to the Father except through me." Saint John Paul II said, "We are now standing in the face of the greatest historical confrontation humanity has gone through. I do not think that wide circles of the American society or wide circles of the Christian community realize this fully. We are now facing the final confrontation between the Church and the anti-Church, of the Gospel versus the anti-Gospel." We are blessed because we know Jesus and we know He will take care of us. We know this is all humility. I do see that the prophetic truth of John Paul II is coming true, more and more, day by day. We can only beg, God: O Lord, "have mercy on us and on the whole world."

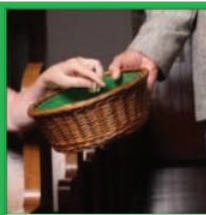


Needed: TURKEYS, HAMS, GRAVY, YAMS (preferably smaller cans), STUFFING & CRANBERRY SAUCE




