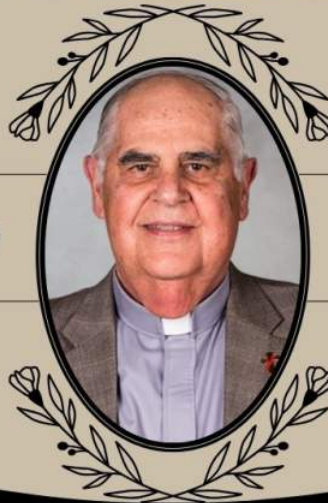

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Thursday, we buried our beloved Deacon Jack Werner. Deacon Jack was a husband, father, grandfather, and friend to so many. He was an ordained Permanent Deacon who served faithfully at Saint Agnes and eventually, Our Lady of Hope Parish. It was a challenging few years for Deacon as he lost his wife Joanne and then became sick himself. He could not get past his illness and the Lord took him home to Himself. Deacon was cared for by his daughters who lovingly made sure that he was doing his best to keep his health in check. Deacon Jack was a good homilist who prepared well for his preaching, he would do anything that I asked him to do in the name of the Lord. We loved to reminisce about his days in the Oblates of Saint Francis de Sales, his teaching days in Catholic high school, his love for Villanova (especially the basketball team) and his big devotion to all sports in Philadelphia. Deacon Jack always had an air of wisdom and a ready laugh which brought calm to volatile situations. His financial knowledge was a blessing and his devotion to the Diocese of Camden was complete. Deacon Jack was very present at all activities in our parish and as I noted a few weeks ago, he was supposed to be retired yet did more than most active deacons I know. We served on diocesan committees outside Our Lady of Hope Parish which was another opportunity to spend time with this wonderful man. Our parish has lost a good a good deacon and I have lost a friend and confidant. I offer my sympathy to all who got to know Deacon Jack. May the Lord Jesus forgive his sins and bring Deacon Jack into His Eternal Kingdom. Deacon Jack Werner, rest in peace. Thank you for your love for God, for our parish and for each one of us.

Saint Martin de Porres:

Saint Martin was born in Lima, Peru, the son of a white, Spanish nobleman and a freed black woman from Panama. Martin's father resented his dark skinned son and abandoned the family when Martin and his sister were very young. Martin's childhood was full of abuse, neglect, loneliness and poverty, but he knew his heavenly Father loved and cared for him. When Martin was twelve, his mother placed him as an apprentice to be a barber/surgeon. He was overjoyed. He learned remedies that helped sick and suffering people. Martin's days were filled with hospital works, office work and in home visits. In the evenings, he spent long hours reading about God. He became good at his profession and his good name spread through Lima. He became a Dominican lay brother as he felt he was not worthy of becoming a priest. After nine years, he was asked to fully become a priest by his community. As a Dominican, Martin was busier than ever. He was the head of the infirmary in the monastery but he cared for the people of the city as well. At times, he would put his hand on the sick and God would cure them. Martin was so well liked and admired by the people they named him "Martin of Charity". Saint Martin is the patron saint of social justice, and public education. His feast day is November 03, 2024. One interesting fact is Martin was a close friend of Rose of Lima.
