A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Fire often represents that Holy Spirit and is something that we need to survive. When it is not controlled, it risks horror and destruction as we saw in Lahaina, Maui. I was blessed to be in that beautiful town in the state of Hawaii and the thought that fires have destroyed it is so sad. Last Sunday, I was going from the rectory to the church and smelled a terrible scent. I looked around and saw the smokey haze of the wildfires that were raging in pockets of our state. Isaiah 48:5 says, "You heavens above, rain down my righteousness; let the clouds shower it down. Let the earth open wide, let salvation spring up, let righteousness flourish with it; I, the Lord, have created it." I see the fires around the world...in Ukraine, the Holy Land, Amsterdam, and many hot spots that are aflame with hatred and destruction. We see people overreacting to the recent election: some hot with anger and bitterness. We need God's grace to rain down upon us and put out the flames that are destroying goodness in our world. We have a prayer group called Flames of Fire...am I describing all fire as wrong? No, Flames of Fire is the fire of the Holy Spirit that while it is hot, it is hot with love, with passion, with a desire for God and not for the empty, uncontrolled fire that the evil one is setting. My sister, of happy memory, lived in Las Vegas and when it rained, which was a rarity, she told me that she would get out her lawn chair and just sit in the rain. We must spend time in calming prayer and allow ourselves to feel that love of God rain down upon us. We must not let bitterness and irrational anger take our peace and burn uncontrolled within our soul. Calm, smoldering love is the fire we desire. We know that God wants to grow in our hearts, but as [Michael Boadi Nyamekye](#) says, "God blesses what you plant; if you plant nothing, weeds will grow when He sends down the rain." Our crops need rain, our grotto needs rain, and we need rain to put out the wildfires. Spiritually, we need the rain of grace to put out the fires of evil in our souls and to allow our parched souls to come alive in Christ. As the hymn sings, "Rain down, rain down, rain down Your love on Your people." Amen!

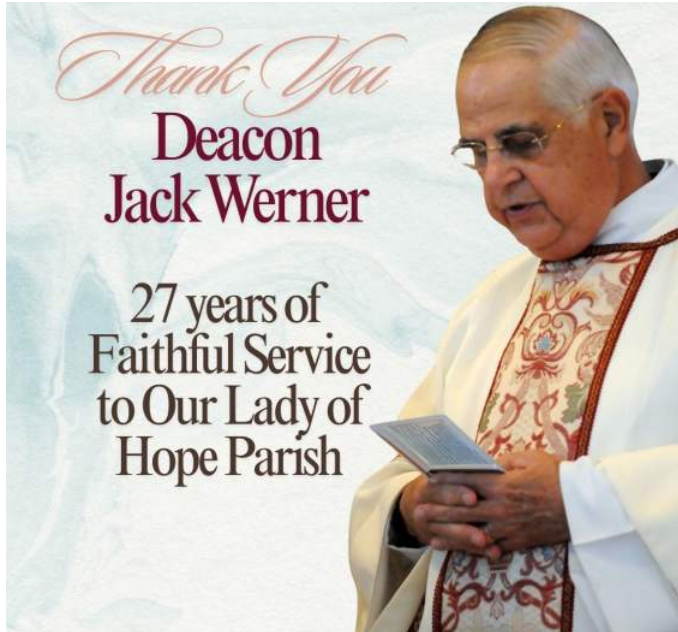
