A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving as a nation, I want to assure the faithful of Our Lady of Hope that I consider it a privilege to serve you and to serve God along with you. As Scripture offers, "I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him" (Ephesians 1:16-23). The traditional antidote to selfishness which seems so prevalent in our society is thanksgiving. When we examine our conscience at night, we should spend more time thanking the Lord than going over sins and asking forgiveness. Certainly we need to be aware of our sins and repent, but Saint Ignatius of Loyola reminds us that the blessing, goodness and generosity of God are so much larger than even our foolish sins. These words apply to our current time. I would think it a time to give thanks for the blessings upon our nation and to put aside this Thursday any anger and negativity. There is so much strife in the world that despite the challenges to our country, we remain blessed by the favor of Almighty God. On behalf of the priests, deacons and staff of Our Lady of Hope, we wish you a very blessed and enjoyable Thanksgiving holiday.

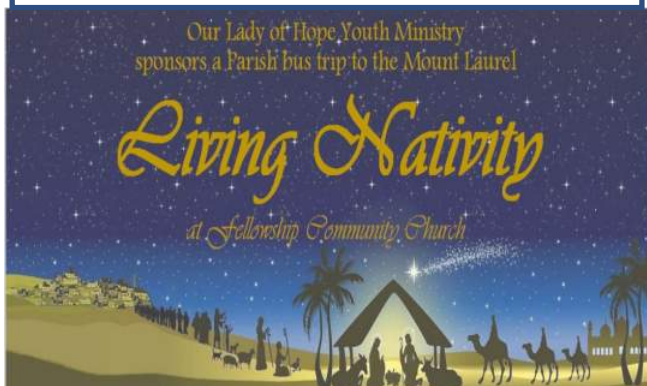
