A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

We now have a very short time until we celebrate the wonderful Solemnity of the Birth of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We know that the birth of a baby changes everything forever in our lives whether it is our own child, grandchild, niece, or a spiritual child. New life is a great gift of God. We look forward to the Lord being born within our souls every day, but we especially are filled with great love and joy in Jesus at the celebration of His birth. Pope Saint Leo the Great spoke of the great joy we must have this time of year: "Sadness should have no place on the birthday of life. The fear of death has been swallowed up; life brings us joy with the promise of eternal happiness. No one is shut out from this joy; all share the same reason for rejoicing. Our Lord, victor over sin and death, finding no man free from sin, came to free us all." We may miss loved ones; we may miss Christmases from the past; or we may be going through a painful time right now. **Blessing & Prayers
for Advent Wreath**



FOURTH WEEK *The prayer that follows is to be repeated each day of the fourth week. After the prayer, the father lights all four candles.*

Leader: O Lord, stir up Thy power, we pray Thee, and come; and with great might help us, that with the help of Thy Grace, Thy merciful forgiveness may hasten what our sins impede. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The four candles are allowed to burn during the evening meals of the fourth week.

After the fourth week, the penitential season of Advent is over and the time to rejoice is at hand. The Advent wreath is transformed into a Christmas wreath. Ribbon and candles are replaced with red ribbon and long red or white tapers (to be lighted at breakfast on Christmas morning) and, if desired, other festive decorations can be added.

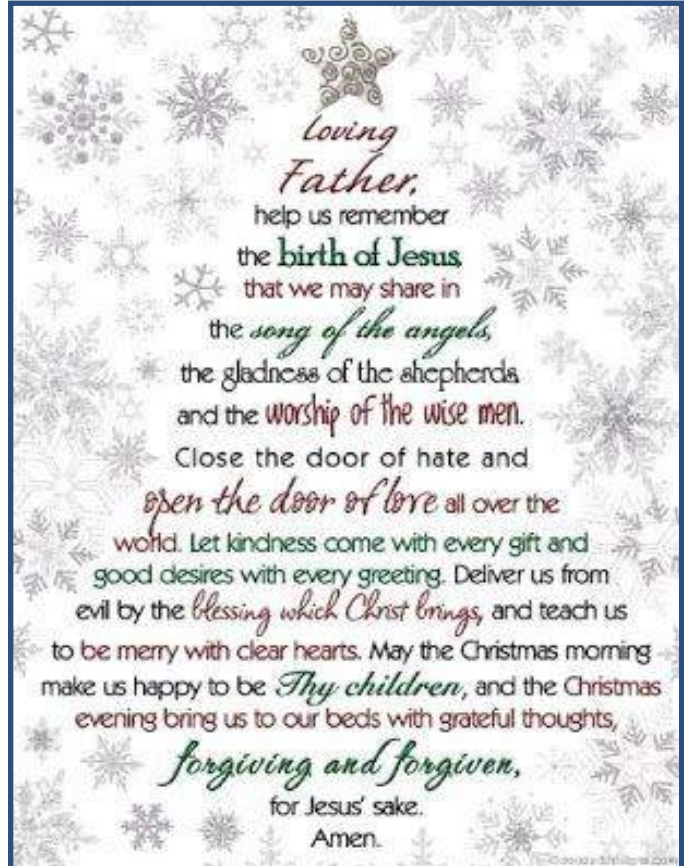

Christmas Day :

Mary brought for a son, wrapped him in swaddling clothing and laid him in a manger because there was no room at the inn. We have all heard the story a thousand times but most of us have not heard these account of Christmas.

The history of the first Christmas is made familiar to Catholics by the devotion of the "Christmas Crib". In 1226, Dt. Francis of Assisi, with permission of the Pope, set up the first of these cribs for the purpose of instructing the people and increasing in their hearts love and devotion for the Infant Savior.

Christmas takes its name from the central and supreme act of Christian worship. Christmas mean "Christ's Mass", the Mass offered in honor of the birth of Christ. Nearly all European languages, except English, use a word signifying nativity or birthday of Christ to designate the feat of Christmas: in Latin, Dies Natalis; in Italian, Il Natale and in French the softened form Noel. In all lands and languages the great fact commemorated is the birth of Christ, and renewed in Mass. On Christmas priests may celebrate three Masses to honor the threefold birth of the Son of God; His birth in time and in our humanity in the stable of Bethlehem; His spiritual birth by faith and charity in the souls of the shepherds and in our souls and in the souls of all who earnestly seek Him; lastly, His eternal generation in the bosom of the Father.


