## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have mentioned before that my favorite word in the entire world is "Jesus." 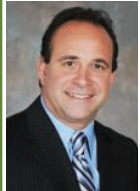
