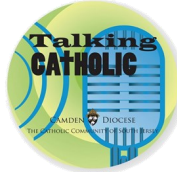

If it is a student email, you will not be notified by email because our system will not email minors. Make sure phone number and parents signature are on your forms. Communion 2025:

First Holy Communion 2025 is upon us. Please be sure to submit all sacrament forms, baptismal certificates or registrations for children intending on making Communion for 2025.
