A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Recently, we had a large group of our men go on an annual retreat at Saint Joseph, Malvern. I loved seeing their enthusiasm for time spent with the Lord. This is a beautiful tradition in our parish and in the entire Delaware Valley. Perhaps you have seen a bumper sticker with Men of Malvern on it witnessing that every year the occupant goes on a weekend to renew themselves spiritually. Bishops, priests and deacons are bound by Canon Law to go on a yearly retreat. This is a great time for us and I am so pleased that we are mandated to retreat each year. Certainly, there is no force on my part to go on retreat, but any time in extended prayer is more than beneficial for one's soul. I do know that everyone does not have the capability of going away on a retreat for many reasons, but developing one's prayer life is essential. Normally, we would have had our Forty Hours at this time, but for a few reasons we were unable to have it at this immediate time. I will be announcing very soon the dates for our annual Forty Hours Celebration. Psalm 17:6 says, "I call on You my God, for You will answer me; turn Your ear to me and hear my prayer." I am confident that the Lord loves to hear from us, especially when we pray from our hearts. Please remember that the chapel is open every day from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM and that every Friday we have Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the chapel from the conclusion of the 9:00 AM Mass until 6:30 PM. First Fridays, we have a Mass in honor of the Sacred Heart at 7:00 PM followed by prayer and adoration until 11:30 PM. At 12:00 Midnight, we have Holy Mass offered in honor of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Spending time with our Bible and praying the Holy Rosary are other ways to grown in meditation which leads to contemplation. We need prayer like we need air to breathe, food to eat and to rest our bodies. J. C. Ryle, in *The Call to Prayer* states, "To be prayerless is to be without God, without Christ, without grace, without hope, and without heaven. It is to be on the road to hell. Now can you wonder that I ask the question, Do you pray?" This is a challenge to us all. In this new year, let us commit to more prayer, deeper prayer, sincere prayer and frequent prayer.

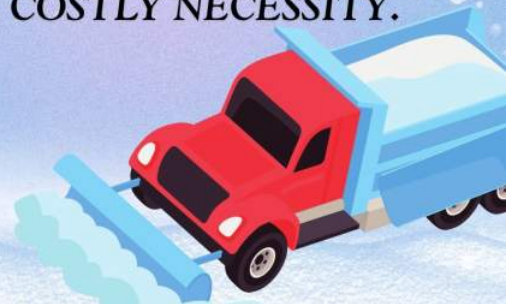
