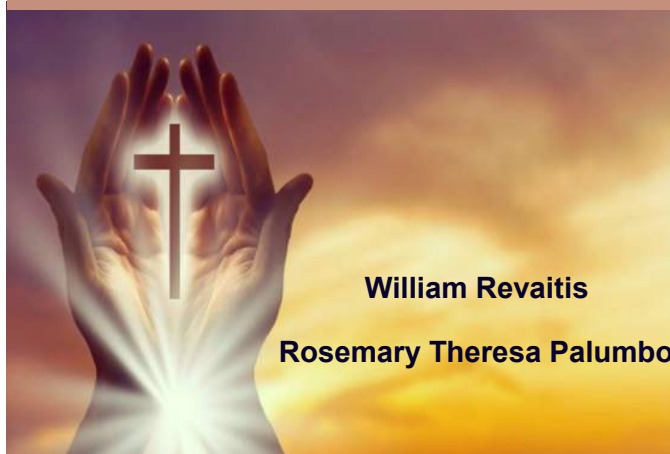

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, we are kicking off another year of the South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal (formerly House of Charity). While this campaign has been renamed the South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal, the needs are as acute as ever. Our goal is a lofty one, but we pray in the name of the Lord that we can reach our goal in order to carry out the work of Jesus in our midst. Our goal this year, as assigned by the Diocese, is \$204,900.00 which is down from \$210,200.00. thus, I know that we can achieve our goal. Even more important than the goal itself, is what your generosity accomplishes in the lives of so many. The theme this year is *Our Journey United in Hope*. I love seeing the word “hope” in the theme since our patroness, Our Lady of Hope is carrying the HOPE of the world, our Savior. The film that we will watch at all the Masses shows us how your gift will reach so many people. Always close to my heart is the assistance you offer to our future priests, who are so brave in answering the call from Our Lord to possibly serve as a priest, a servant of God. We have been blessed to have excellent seminarians with us and our parish has helped to train great pastors: Father Kennedy and Father March. St. Paul instructs us to smile when we give so let us encounter the living God when we see the smile of the person who is in desperate need and who is saved by our generosity. Thank you so much in advance. May the video inspire you and may we give in the name of the Lord!



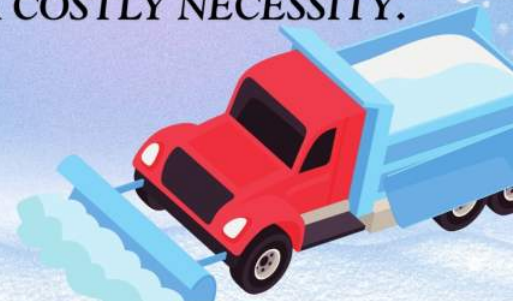
