A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

The powerful season of Lent begins this week. We start the penitential season on March 5 which is Ash Wednesday. Please see the schedule in the bulletin or the parish website for the Ash Wednesday Schedule. The traditional program for Lent is prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We have some blessed opportunities to live out this program within our parish community. On Fridays during Lent, we will have our Soup and Scripture Nights from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM. This involves eating a meatless soup cooked by one of the parish ministries and bread and then a talk along with an opportunity to discuss the topic at hand. The theme this year is "The Beatitudes." The Stations of the Cross will be celebrated at 7:30 PM in the church, after the Soup and Scripture. As for the Sacrament of Penance, we are offering confessions at the usual times on Saturday, every Monday night 7:30 PM (after the Miraculous Medal Novena) and every Wednesday at 7:00 PM during Lent. We are also called to give alms to the poor and as our Charity Appeal continues to unfold, we have the opportunity to make our sacrifice for Jesus in His disguise as the poor. Please give to this charity. We will also have our Forty Hours during Lent this year. I will announce that information next week. As we prepare to enter into the spiritual desert to cleanse our souls and to reawaken our understanding of the need for God the few days before Ash Wednesday still gives us time to plan our Lenten program. We must identify our weaknesses and see our spiritual strengths in order to plan our prayer and fasting program. Our chapel is open every day from 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM. Time with our Lord, spiritual reading, the Holy Rosary, Confession, penance, etc. are beautiful ways to grow in faith, hope and love in God. Do not forget the Lenten fasting regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence (no meat) and fasting. The fast in the Roman Catholic Church is that from 18 - 59 one is permitted one full meal and two meals that do not equal the one meal. Actually, I think this is rather liberal, so I would be stricter than that which is presented by the Church at this time. Abstinence or no meat is observed, under pain of mortal sin, every Friday during Lent. Lent means "springtime." May our love for the Lord blossom in a most powerful way this year.

While you were growing up, you may have heard of fulfilling your "*Easter Duty*," going to Confession and then receiving Holy Communion, sometime during the year. In actuality, your "Easter Duty" is a precept of the Church (along with attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, observing the days of fast and abstinence established by the Church, and helping to provide for the needs of the Church). They are in addition to the Ten Commandments and are "positive" laws ... things you should do as opposed to things you shouldn't do.



Performing your "Easter Duty" becomes a little more significant if you do not attend Mass regularly and receive Holy Communion. In the United States, this year, fulfilling your Easter Duty can happen beginning the First Sunday of Lent (March 9, 2025) until Trinity Sunday (June 15, 2025). Please check our schedule for Penance times and as always, you can always call the Parish Office and request an appointment with a Priest.

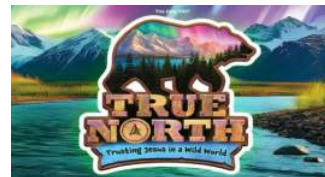

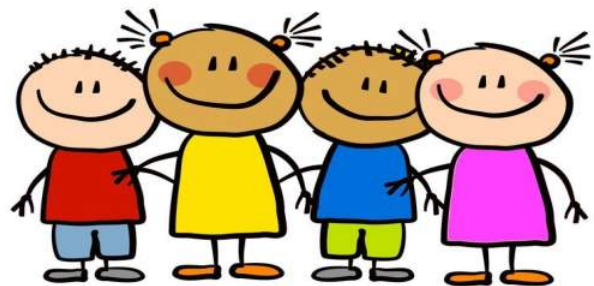
Communion 2025:
