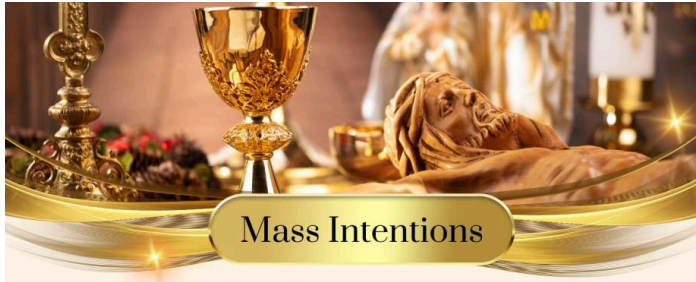

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

The whole world continues to respond to the death of the Vicar of Christ, Pope Francis. Many people are expressing where they were or when they found out that Pope Francis had died. While I was not shocked, as the Pope was clearly in terrible health, although he was blessed to be able to ride around Saint Peter's Square to greet the faithful one last time. It is an extraordinary grace that the Holy Father was called by God on Easter Monday during the Octave of Easter. As usual, the Lord was good to me. My mother is traveling in Tajikistan and therefore, I took Easter dinner in Wildwood. On Easter Monday, I traveled to Washington, D.C. to the Bible Museum and to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception with Latino community from North Cape May. Our bus was leaving at 4:30 AM and when I awoke, I was informed that Pope Francis had died. I say that it was a blessing because I could pray at the Shrine of Our Lady and was present for a Holy Mass being celebrated by the Nuncio, Cardinal Pierre. I concelebrated Holy Mass with our pilgrims with Father Cesar Pirateque and Father Thomas Sodano in the Chapel of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It was a very powerful and blessed day. Please know that I prayed for our parish as well. For Pope Francis: Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord! May perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful rest in peace. Amen.

This Sunday, April 27th is Divine Mercy Sunday. We will celebrate with Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish in Lindenwold from 2:00 PM – 5:30 PM. Celebrations will be spoken in English and Spanish with the honoring of the Divine Mercy Image; confessions; music, Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament at 4:00 PM; followed by Holy Mass at 4:30 PM. The location of our celebration is at the Saint Lawrence Church, 135 White Horse Pike, Lindenwold.

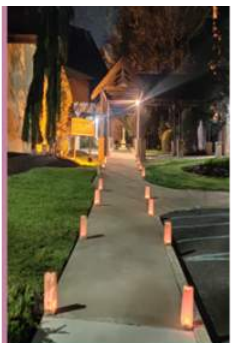

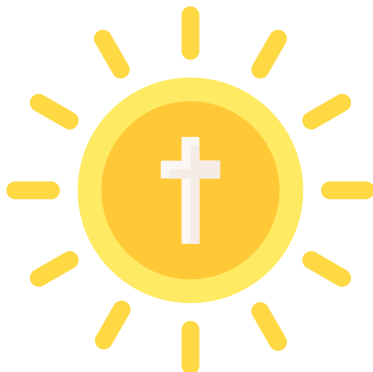
