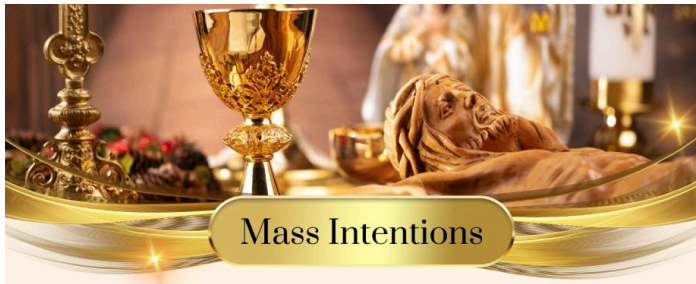

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*

Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, I want to thank everyone who was faithful to all the opportunities to worship the Lord during the Holy Triduum and now into the Easter Season. The Lord was very good to our parish and to all who made everything so beautiful, so spiritual, I give thanks to the Lord for you. I can only be grateful to the Lord to make me the pastor of the greatest of parishes! This is certainly a time for huge changes in our local Church and in the Universal Catholic Church. Our new shepherd, Bishop Williams, is now in charge of the Diocese of Camden, and we are grateful that we have a spiritual, intelligent, and personable bishop to lead us ever closer to the Lord Jesus. If that were not enough change, the cardinals will soon enter conclave to elect a new Vicar of Christ to lead over one billion Catholics in the world. Please continue to pray for the soul of Pope Francis and it would be wrong to state he is in heaven which is presumptuous. We all need purification to go before the Lord and it would be a crime to not pray for the pope. One asks who I think the next pope will be. Naturally, I have no answer, but I am praying for the cardinals to elect a holy, intelligent, personable, and orthodox pope who loves the traditions of the Church and all that reflects our long history of love for the Lord Jesus Christ. Please see all the events during these three days and be sure to sign up for your time before the Lord. The church will be open day and night during our celebration. Our holiest will be Father Cesar Pirateque Serrano. Father Cesar is a wonderful priest who is familiar to many of you. Father has been ordained three years this month and hails originally from Bogota, Colombia. Father is an assistant priest at Saint John Neumann Parish in North Cape May and is the priest for Latinos in all of Cape May County. Father has an intense love for the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and loves the Most Blessed Virgin Mary in the deepest way. Father Cesar will help us to desire the Lord in His Real Presence. I especially invite our friends from Saint Jude Community as Father is bilingual and will hear confessions as part of our three days. Please come out as much as possible and see the schedule for the numerous prayer events during these very holy three days.
