Dear Friends in Christ,

In our diocese, this is ordination weekend. What a blessed time! As you read this, we will have two new priests in our diocese ordained by our new Ordinary, Bishop Joseph Williams. I am proud to call brother priests: Father Timothy Mulranen and Father Thomas Piro. I was ordained on May 28, 1988, at Saint Joseph Pro-Cathedral and offered my First Mass at Saint Bridget Church in Glassboro. I was recently in that same church in Glassboro for the funeral of a wonderful priest, Monsignor James Tracy. Monsignor was the pastor when I was ordained and was so generous to me in so many ways. I learned so much from him and was blessed to call him mentor and friend. As we welcome two new priests and say goodbye to a true priestly servant, I want to thank the Lord for calling me to be a priest and to serve at Our Lady of Hope Parish. At first, it was a challenge to leave Infant Jesus Parish in Woodbury Heights, which I loved so very dearly. It was on my first Christmas Eve (my favorite holiday) at Our Lady of Hope that I received a great grace. St. Leonard of Port Maurice once said, "What tongue, human or angelic, may ever describe a power so immeasurable as that exercised by the simplest priest in Mass? Who could ever have imagined that the voice of man, which by nature hath not the power even to raise a straw from the ground, should obtain through grace a power so stupendous as to bring from Heaven to earth the Son of God?" Please pray for this priest and all of us who are called to serve you. Finally, I can only say that words that I hope to have on my lips as I die, "I love You, O Lord, my strength!" (Psalm 18:1).

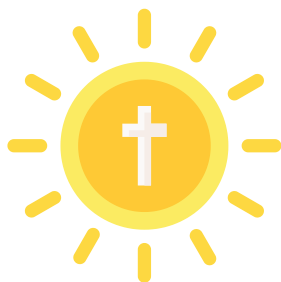
