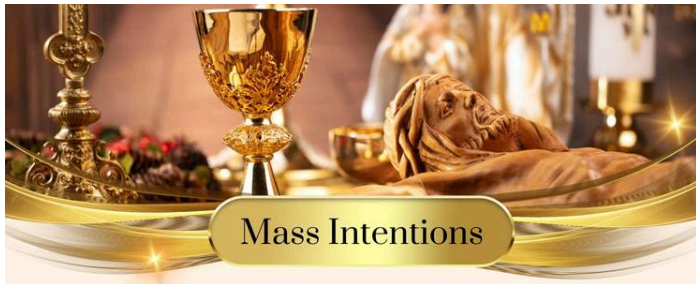

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

In Saint Paul's Letter to the Colossians we read, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." (Colossians 3:16-17). The spiritual life can sometimes be a challenge or an effort at best. We do not always see the fruits of our spiritual labor and thus, prayer is something that we fit into the rest of our day. We realize that the Lord, who labored for our salvation, lifts the work that is done in His name to a whole new, supernatural level. The motto that Saint Ignatius of Loyola gave to his Society of Jesus is Ad majorem Dei gloriam: To the greater glory of God. Everything that we offer to the Lord allows it to be touched by His grace and it purifies and blesses our intentions. With prayer and offering to God, the least attractive of day can be blessed encounters with the Lord. Our spiritual life takes work; a lot of work. The Lord is our great example as He spent long hours praying in far off places. We too must fulfill our spiritual commitments: never missing Holy Mass on Sundays, reading the Bible, praying the Holy Rosary, and going to confession regularly. These basics are the foundation of our life, and we might add additional prayers that bring us to the feet of the Lord. The Morning Offering is most beneficial. When we commit all that we will do in the day, first thing in the morning, we call the Lord to bless those moments that unfold throughout the day. A traditional prayer for one's Morning Offering is the following:

O Jesus,
through the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
I offer You my prayers, works,
joys and sufferings
of this day for all the intentions
of Your Sacred Heart,
in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass
throughout the world,
in reparation for my sins,
for the intentions of all my relatives and friends,
and
for the intentions of the Holy Father.
Amen.

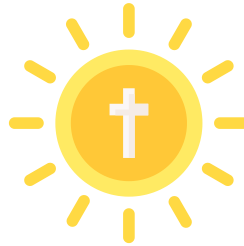

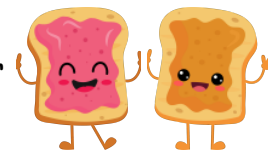
