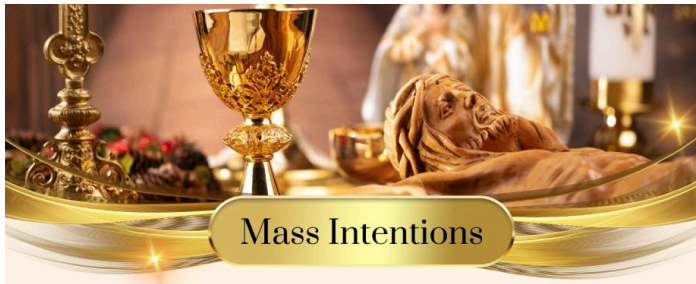

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

Recently, I was monitoring the massive flooding in the Philippines. It was unbelievable to see people wading in the streets and even attending Holy Mass in feet of water. Typically, the Filipino people would not stop attending Holy Mass despite their church being flooded! Of course, we still shiver from the horrific stories of the flooding in Texas, especially the flooding that took the lives of young campers. We saw the flooding in North Jersey in Plainfield and the flooding of the subway system in New York City. The water is so crazy that we cannot help but think of Sacred Scripture. "For forty days the flood kept coming on the earth, and as the waters increased, they lifted the ark high above the earth. The waters rose and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the surface of the water. They rose greatly on the earth, and all the high mountains under the entire heavens were covered. The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than fifteen cubits. Every living thing that moved on land perished – birds, livestock, wild animals, all the creatures that swarm over the earth, and all mankind. Everything on dry land that had the breath of life in its nostrils died. Every living thing on the face of the earth was wiped out; people and animals and the creatures that move along the ground and the birds were wiped from the earth." (Genesis 6:17-23). Certainly, I do not want to jump to conclusions. Personally, I watch the weather for reminders from God over concern about the "green house effect." I believe that we must care for the planet, but we need to live and some things occur naturally despite mankind. I am more concerned if the Lord is speaking to us through these events. Manmade calamities certainly are damaging our world...man sins and his lack of love for God and one's fellow man are destroying the beauty of God's goodness. God is reminding us that He is in charge, and we must cooperate with His loving plan, or we will, at least, drown in our own sin. The spiritual basics are essential for us to keep our heads above water. Attending Holy Mass every Sunday, without fail, without excuses, confessing our sins sacramentally and prayer throughout our day are so necessary. Charity, love for neighbor is our physical expression of our love for God. If we truly love the Lord our God and our neighbor as devout Catholics we do not need to be swallowed up in a sea of fear. Psalm 29:10 says, "The Lord sits enthroned over the flood; the Lord is enthroned as King forever." In the Christian song "Flood" by Jars of Clay, we hear words that remind us to call out to the Lord when overwhelmed:

Rain, rain on my face
It hasn't stopped raining for days
My world is a flood
Slowly I become one with the mud

But if I can't swim after forty days
And my mind is crushed by the crashing waves
Lift me up so high that I cannot fall
Lift me, oh

Lift me up - when I'm falling
Lift me up - I'm weak and I'm dying
Lift me up - I need you to hold me
Lift me up - keep me from drowning again

Downpour on my soul
Splashing in the ocean, I'm losing control
Dark sky all around
I can't feel my feet touching the ground

Calm the storms that drench my eyes
And dry the streams still flowing
Casting down all the waves of sin
And guilt that overthrow me

But if I can't swim after forty days
And my mind is crushed by the crashing waves
Lift me up so high that I cannot fall
Lift me, oh

Lift me up - when I'm falling
Lift me up - I'm weak and I'm dying
Lift me up - I need you to hold me
Lift me up - keep me from drowning again.

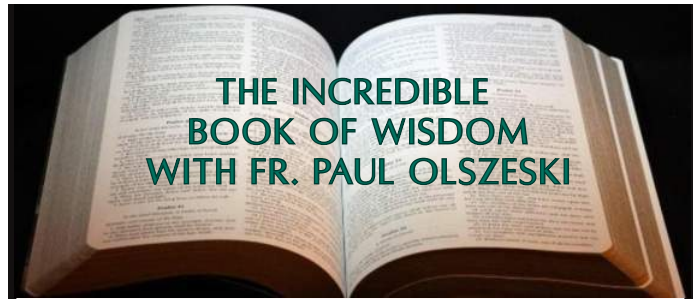

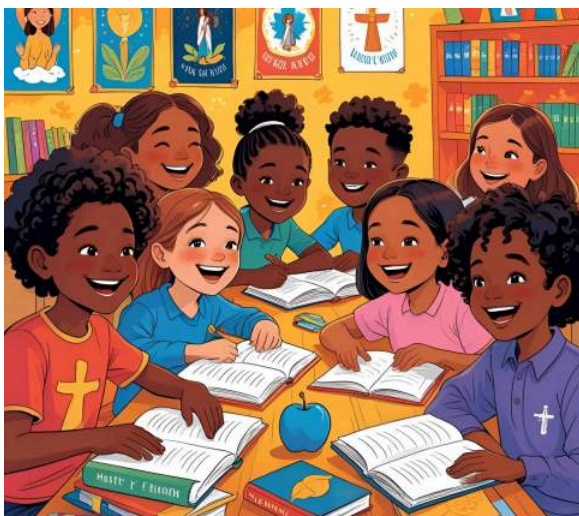
