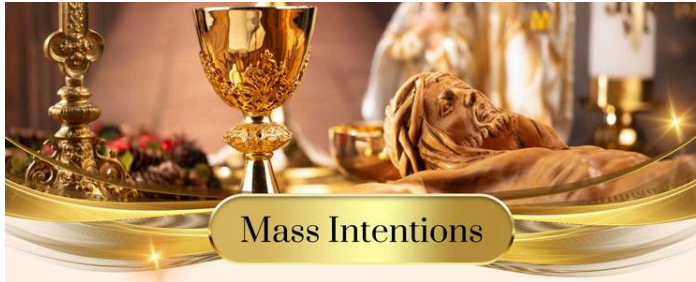

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary calls to mind her appearance to the children of Fatima: Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta. There is a great deal of mystery surrounding Our Lady of Fatima, a mystery that calls us to conversion and consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady said many things about the state of our world in 1917 and what would come should we not turn back to God. Imagine how much worse it is today than 1917! The internet allows poison to spread more quickly and efficiently. In an article written by Father Richard Heilman, we read, “Central to the Enlightenment agenda was the assault on, what they held as, ‘religious superstition’ and its replacement by rational religion, which is most commonly referred to as Deism. Deism is a heresy which holds that God became no more than the supreme intelligence or craftsman who had set the machine that was the world to run according to its own natural and scientifically predictable laws. In other words, God created it and then left it (It is believed that most of our founding fathers were Deists ... a heresy which became entrenched around the time of the birth of our nation). As our Lady was appearing in Fatima, it is important to note that in 1917, the same year the Communist Revolution in Russia was unleashed, Pope Benedict XV penned an encyclical entitled, Humani Generis Redemptionem. It would prove to be prophetic. In it he addressed an issue that had to be ‘looked upon as a matter of the greatest and most momentous concern.’ Up until 1917, Western Civilization had begun to drift away from the light of Gospel. The Reformation, the French Revolution and, as mentioned, the Russian Revolution, were highly instrumental in ushering in the era of secularism. Pope Benedict XV could not escape the conclusion that the world was changing. He wrote the following in the same encyclical: ‘If on the other hand we examine the state of public and private morals, the constitutions and laws of nations, we shall find that there is a general disregard and forgetfulness of the supernatural, a gradual falling away from the strict standards of Christian virtue, and that men are slipping back more and more into the shameful practices of paganism.’” Father Heilman would go on to quote Pope Benedict XVI, “In speaking of the need for a New Evangelization, Pope Benedict XVI said, ‘the true problem of our times is the Crisis of God, the absence of God, disguised by an empty religiosity’ ... a kind of lukewarm, going through the motions of one’s faith, which ends up collapsing completely. The terrible consequence of this war on the supernatural is seen in the epidemic of spiritual sloth in our times – hearts deadened to the Divine Life of God.” There are those that believe that the Church exists merely to give us a vehicle to do good and to entertain us with stand-up comedy and flashy music. We need only look around the world: Russia, the Holy Land, Ukraine, North Korea, and Venezuela to name a few hot spots. One would think these times would cause our churches to be full in asking for God’s mercy and committing ourselves to be the children for which we created. No, we are not heeding the warnings, and we forget that we go to Mass to give worship and love to the Lord our God, not to reject Him when we are not entertained enough. Is my message pessimistic and too apocryphal? I am only reading the signs in our midst and with all hope realize that unless we return to the Lord, heading Our Mother Mary’s call, we are in for days that are going to challenge our very being. If we choose God, we choose life...life in Him. A life without fear and darkness because as Pope Benedict recently told the newly created cardinals: “God always wins in the end.” When we walk with the Lord, we do not have to be afraid. We live in the Light. We continue to pray for Pope Leo, that he will continue to inspire us to reach for the heights of union with God.


