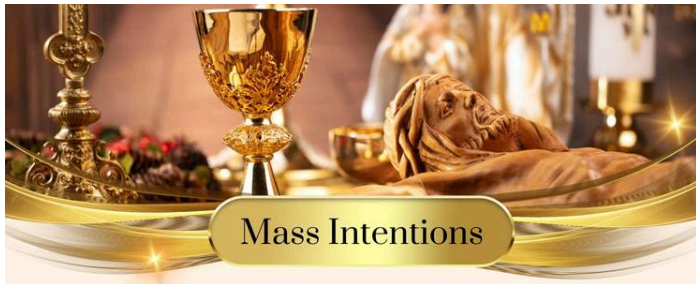

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

I always considered it a blessing to have been in the presence of Pope Saint John Paul II and had the blessing to have Mother Teresa kiss my hand. I miss both of them, but I know that they are doing more work from Heaven. We see God's loving action in the recognition of Mother Teresa as a saint to whom we can pray and to whom we can look to for inspiration. Not only did I have the blessing of meeting Mother Teresa, but I have worked with her sisters, offering Mass for the Missionaries of Charity (the religious order Mother founded), hearing their confessions, and offering retreats. Mother Teresa was inspired to form a community that would "sate the thirst of Jesus." This thirst was not for water, but for love. Jesus thirsts for our love. Mother would encourage loving trust, total surrender, and cheerfulness...all for Jesus. She would take the spirituality of Saint Terese, the Little Flower, who taught, "Small things with great love." Yes, we can do the most ordinary, everyday things, but when we allow them to be touched by God, they become infinite. God's love is infinite, and we can share in His love. Some of us were told when confronted with a challenge to "offer it up." This is still good advice. When asked what made a saint, Mother Teresa said that whether one finds themselves in a palace or a gutter, they should smile at God. The secret is not to put ourselves in the palace or the gutter. This is the surrender to Him. Her community continues to perform unthinkable acts of mercy. When asked how they do it, Mother simply said, "Mass and Holy Communion." Recently, when offering Mass, our children were present, and I told them that they would only be happy if they knew God. I know this to be absolutely true. Without the Lord we are lost. When we go to Mass and receive Our Lord in a state of grace, we touch Heaven for some brief moments. This is going to be especially important when we find ourselves before the Lord. Mother Teresa, Saint Teresa, saw Jesus in the poorest of the poor. If we look in the mirror and see our own poor image, we will see Jesus. Yes, we will see Him...if we know Him. Mother once said, "Do not think that love in order to be genuine has to be extraordinary. What we need is to love without getting tired. Be faithful in small things because it is in them that your strength lies." Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta, pray for us!

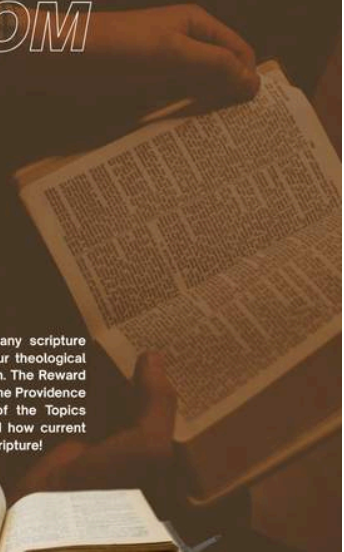
