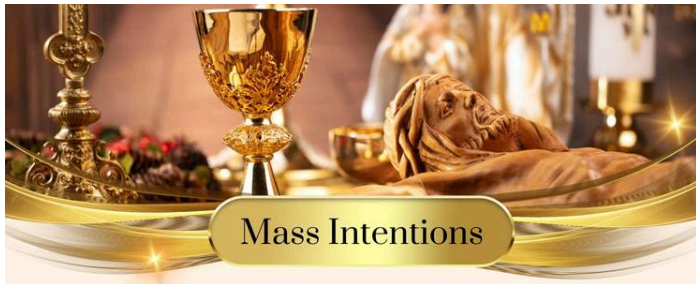

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past weekend, we had a Mass that celebrated our parish's proud cultures from the African continent. Whether from Nigeria, Cameroon, Nigeria, Ghana, Rwanda, South Africa, Kenya or another of the countries that hail from Africa, we were blessed to celebrate with wonderful music, colorful pageantry, guests from other parishes and delicious, traditional food in our hall. At the Mass, I was pleased to announce that Bishop Joseph Williams has called our parishioner, Paschal C. Nwako, to be ordained a Permanent Deacon. We rejoice with the Church at large, with our diocese, our parish and with Paschal's family on his call from the Bishop. A man cannot be ordained without this call. The letter from Father Dudo, Vicar for Clergy, announced that the ordination for Paschal will take place on Saturday, October 4, 2025, at 10:30 AM in Saint Agnes Church, Blackwood. The banns or announcement for Pascal are in the bulletin, and I will write to Bishop Willimas to ensure that we announced the banns both in the bulletin and vocally. It was a special day for me to announce this since Paschal was present at the African Mass and that we could congratulate this man from Nigeria, who has a wonderful wife, Madonna, four children and his grandsons. You know Paschal from his work as a Lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and as a sacristan. Paschal will join the Order of Deacon, joining our own deacons, Deacons Michael Harkins (retired), Andy Encarnado, Robert Foley and Tobias Haley. We certainly miss the deceased Deacon Jack Werner, who, to me was a friend and as pastor, he was a great confidant. Paschal will bring great gifts of intelligence, dignity and a love for God and His Church to his ministry in the Lord's vineyard. Please keep Paschal in your prayers as his soul is changed forever.
